Energy (2 goals)

1. To foster development that reduces the use of nonrenewable energy resources and expands the use of renewable resources and alternative fuels. (6 policies, 2 actions)

Policies

- Encourage the use of energy conservation techniques and technology in existing and proposed developments to improve energy conservation.
- Protect existing development from loss of solar access.
- Encourage the use of renewable energy sources and alternative fuels.
- Require new subdivisions to examine the feasibility of incorporating site layouts that allow for passive solar heating and cooling.
- Encourage new development to incorporate measures that reduce energy use through solar orientation by taking advantage of shade, prevailing winds, landscaping, and sun screens.

Actions

- Continue to adopt the following energy saving steps for Town facilities and operations ...
 - Study possible measures to improve energy and water efficiency in existing buildings as part of the development of a Climate Action Plan.
2. To promote green buildings that minimize consumption of energy and natural resources. (14 policies, 7 actions)
